February 18, 2020

Spring Primary Election

There will be a Statewide Primary on February 18, 2020.

Absentee Voting at the Village Hall is available to voters who are unable or unwilling to vote at their polling location on Election Day and for those who prefer not to receive a ballot in the mail.

Mail Ballots. Upon receiving your email or written request, your ballot will be mailed to you at your address of choice. Include a copy of your photo ID along with your request. Voted ballots are due back to the Clerk's Office no later than Election Day. You must be registered to receive a ballot in the mail.

Polls will be open from 7 am – 8 pm

Voter Registration: Up to 20 days before an election you may register to vote online and via mail. You may register in-person in your municipal clerk's office up until the Friday before the election at 5:00 p.m. or close of business, whichever is later. And, you may register to vote at the polls on Election Day. You must always provide a Proof of Residence document when registering to vote.
