

**VILLAGE OF GERMANTOWN
BOARD OF CANVASSERS
MEETING MINUTES
April 09, 2021**

CALL TO ORDER: The meeting was called to order at 3:00 p.m. by Village Clerk Braunschweig.

ROLL CALL: Members Lynn Grgich, Kathleen Sitzberger and Village Clerk Braunschweig were present. Joy Gettelman, Noreen Janzen, and Deputy Village Clerk Hubrich were also present.

MINUTES: February 19, 2021

Motion (Grgich, Janzen) to approve the minutes from the February 19, 2021 meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

CANVASS OF April 6th, 2021 SPRING ELECTION - MUNICIPAL RESULTS: The Board of Canvassers reviewed the results for the Spring Election held on April 2, 2019 in the Village of Germantown.

District 1, Wards 1, 8, 10, and 11: The total number of votes cast for Village Trustee in District 1 was 723 votes, of which:

Terri Kaminski received 710 votes.

District 2, Wards 2, 5, 6 and 7: The total number of votes cast for Village Trustee in District 2 was 751 votes, of which:

Kevin Schodron received 335 votes.

Bill Neureuther received 408 votes.

District 3, Wards 3, 4, 9, 16 and 17: The total number of votes cast for Village Trustee in District 3 was 638 votes, of which:

Dennis Myers received 626 votes.

District 4, Wards 12, 13, 14 and 15: The total number of votes cast for Village Trustee in District 4 was 891 votes, of which:

Wyatt O. Wiehr received 341 votes.

Jan Miller received 547 votes.

The Municipal Board of Canvassers Summary Statement and Certification declared the following persons as receiving the greatest number of votes for Village Trustee in the Village of Germantown for the April 6, 2021, Spring Election:

District 1-Terri Kaminski receiving 710 votes.

District 2- Bill Neureuther receiving 408 votes.

District 3- Dennis Myers receiving 626 votes.

District 4 Jan Miller receiving 547 votes.

Motion (Grgich, Sitzberger) to approve the results and certify the winner of the 2021 Spring Election. Motion carried unanimously.

ADJOURNMENT: There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 3:14 p.m.
