

ORDINANCE NO. 06-17

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT HEAVY TRAFFIC ON COUNTRY AIRE DRIVE BETWEEN STH 145 (FOND DU LAC AVE) AND STH 167 (MEQUON ROAD) AND TO AMEND THE OFFICIAL TRAFFIC MAP TO REFLECT THE SAME

WHEREAS, Wis. Stat. § 349.17(1) authorizes municipalities to regulate heavy traffic upon streets and highways within their corporate limits; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board, having previously adopted § 7.06 of the Municipal Code of Germantown, regulates travel of heavy vehicles upon the streets and highways within the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board previously adopted an Official Traffic Map dated November 1, 1988 which identifies, among other things, locations of heavy traffic routes within the Village; and

WHEREAS, at its May 1, 2017 meeting, the Village’s Public Safety Committee unanimously recommended that heavy traffic be prohibited on Country Aire Drive between State Trunk Highway 145 (Fond du Lac Avenue) and State Trunk Highway 167 (Mequon Road); and

WHEREAS, the regulation of heavy traffic routes within the Village promotes the health, safety and welfare of the Community;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Germantown, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION I:

Section 7.06(1)(a)3. of the Germantown Village Code, is amended to read as follows (Note: Additions are underlined; Deleted text is ~~struck through~~):

- i. Country Aire Drive (Mequon Road [S.T.H. 145-167] to Freistadt Road [C.T.H. F]).
- m. ~~County Aire Drive (S.T.H.145 to Freistadt Road)~~

SECTION II:

The Official Traffic Map of the Village of Germantown, as kept by the Chief of Police pursuant to § 7.02 of the Municipal Code of Germantown, is hereby amended to reflect the change specified in Section I.

SECTION III:

The Director of Public Works is hereby directed and shall erect appropriate traffic signals reflecting the prohibition specified in Section I.

SECTION IV:

The terms and provisions of this ordinance are severable. Should any term or provision of this ordinance be found to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining terms and provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION V:


All ordinances or parts of ordinances contravening the terms of this ordinance are hereby to that extent repealed.
